DEPOSIT AND CANCELLATION POLICY

A deposit of \$1,500 per cottage per week is required to reserve a cottage. Each cottage group has a 10-person capacity. Families will only be issued additional cottages if they exceed the capacity of the group. Deposits must be received within ten (10) days of booking a reservation. The deposit will be credited to your final bill. If a reservation is cancelled prior to April 1st, 50% of the deposit will be refunded. After April 1st, no refund will be made. In both instances, if the cottage is rebooked full deposits will be returned, less a \$50 handling fee. No refund will be made if cancellation occurs after June 1st. No reductions will be made for meals not taken or for any unused portion of reserved time. Should Taconnet need to cancel a reservation due to Covid-19 state mandates your deposit will be fully refunded.

CAMP RULES

Taconnet is owned by the Club Taconnet Unit Owners Association (the "Association") and its members and operated as a camp for several weeks each summer. To help make the camp experience enjoyable for everyone, all guests are required to comply with the camp rules, including rules that are communicated during your stay by Taconnet staff. No pets are allowed, smoking is not permitted, alcohol may not be consumed in the dining room or in the common areas, and jet skis are not permitted.

CAMP EXPERIENCE AND INHERENT RISKS

Activities on the island include swimming, canoeing, boating, tennis and other sports, taking walks, sitting on decks and docks, climbing stairs, and playing indoor and outdoor games. All of these activities come with inherent risks. All guests, including Association members, assume full responsibility for those risks and agree not to sue the Association or its members for any personal injuries or property loss or damage (including loss due to theft) that might result from or occur while participating in activities on the island, renting a cabin on the island, using any facilities, boats, or equipment while a guest or visitor on the island, or using the Taconnet parking lot or access road, even if the injuries or loss result from the negligence or other wrongful conduct of Taconnet staff, an Association member, or another third party.
